Dear Occupant:

We have been selected by your Building Management to provide Pest Control services for Roaches in your home. Although they might not be in your unit, to insure eradication it will be necessary to treat your home anyway. In order to do the best possible job for you we will need your assistance. We would like you to do the following prior to our service.

**Kitchen Remove *items off the top of the refrigerator for inspection and treatment.***

**Bathroom Remove items under sink so we can treat and inspect**

**Bedrooms Remove *Everything from the closets, were water heater is located.* ALSO REMOVE ALL ITEMS FROM HALL CLOSETS.**

**You do not need to leave your unit for this service.**

**The roach has different stages in its life cycle and no single insecticide treatment can eliminate all the stages at one time.**

**It is not unusual to see more roach activity for the next two weeks after our service. Please do not be alarmed. If you are having activity after 30 days from our treatment, notify your complex manager. No additional treatment will be done within this 30 day period.**
